GUIDELINES FOR REQUESTING THE CATTARAUGUS COUNTY FIRE INVESTIGATION TEAM

- 1. For all fires or explosions resulting in fatalities or serious injury and for suspicious fires where a possible cause of arson may exist. All requests should be made as soon as possible for these criteria.
- **2.** For fires where the Duty Chief cannot determine the cause of the fire per General Municipal Law, section 204-d (see attached).
- **3.** If the Incident Commander believes the fire was accidental but would like the fire investigation team to check it out.

CONTRIBUTING CIRCUMSTANCES FOR REQUESTING THE FIRE INVESTIGATION TEAM

- 1. All fire scenes where the fire investigation team has been requested, custody shall be maintained by fire department personnel until the fire investigation team has arrived.
- **2.** Investigators will need information from first firefighters on scene such as:
 - A) Where was the fire located?
 - B) Was there any signs of forced entry into the structure
 - C) Color of smoke and flames
 - D) Were there possible tire tracks or footprints in the area?
- **3.** In the case of fatal fires it is imperative the scenes are left intact as much as possible and bodies are not removed unless they are endangered by fire.
- **4.** The fire investigation team will attempt to determine the origin and cause of all fires but will not be used as an agent for insurance companies or subrogation purposes.
- **5.** If the Incident Commander requests for the fire investigation team fire suppression should continue to preserve any evidence and structural stability.
- **6.** All fire personnel shall stay out of structures and away from all fire investigations unless asked for assistance by the fire investigation team.
- 7. Incident command shall leave one engine and crew at scene until released by fire investigators.
- **8.** If a request is made for the fire investigation team and they are already on another investigation they will prioritize response.
