Health Provider Referral Resource for Patients with Asthma

The Cattaraugus County Health Department Healthy Neighborhoods Program (HNP) accepts referrals from health providers for patients (children and adults) with diagnosed asthma.

How the Healthy Neighborhoods Program Works

After a referral is made, HNP staff will contact the patient and/or family to make an appointment for a home safety visit. During the visit, HNP staff will assess the home and look for pests (mice and roaches) and mold, and building conditions that result in pests and mold, like leaks, cracks and holes.

Once the assessment is complete, HNP staff will work with the patient and/or family to develop a plan to help make their home healthier and safer and provide education and products like cleaning supplies and asthma management tools to help reduce indoor allergens that may be contributing to the asthma diagnosis of those living in the home.
