



FPT 290 Fire Service Independent Study

- Upon successful completion of FPT 290 Independent Fire Service Internship, students will receive 3 credits towards their FPT AAS Degree per semester (up to 6 credits allowed)
- Student shall maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA in order to participate
- Students will serve as an on-duty firefighter, 24 hours per week for 16 weeks
- Students must be an active volunteer firefighter with an agency in New York State, they
 will serve as a mutual aid member for the participating agency
- Student assessment is based upon the total number of logged hours, a two-page written summary which includes major areas of experience and personal growth, and a verbal review with the Fire-Rescue Coordinator
- Options available for live in and non-live in students, contact for further details
- Students must be enrolled in the Monroe Community College Fire Protection Technology
 Degree Program in order to participate
