RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a contract, between the Cattaraugus County Community Services Board and Recovery Options Made Easy, Inc. d/b/a Housing Options Made Easy, Inc., to signify the County's approval, for the provision of the above-mentioned programs, for a term commencing January 1, 2024 and terminating December 31, 2024, according to the above-described terms, and be it further

II. RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, further authorized and directed to execute contract amendments, upon notification of award, for the allocation of additional state aid funding or cost of living adjustments (COLAs) or reduction in funding for this program, and be it further

III. RESOLVED, that upon termination of either state or federal funding for this program, then this program shall be automatically abolished, and be it further

IV. RESOLVED, that such contract shall provide that upon the reduction of any such funding, the County, in its sole discretion, may terminate the contract on thirty (30) days' written notice, and be it further

V. RESOLVED, that upon reduction of either state or federal funding for this program, the County, in its sole discretion, and upon notice, may reduce the rate for services provided by the percentage of reduction in state or federal funding, and be it further

VI. RESOLVED, that in the event of any such reduction, the department head involved shall immediately report such occurrence to the Chairman of the Committee to which the department is assigned, who shall add the matter to the agenda of the Committee's next meeting, and be it further
