- III. WHEREAS, Opferbeck Consulting, Inc., 30 West Street, Cattaraugus, New York 14719, has a need to purchase machinery, equipment and inventory for manufacturing and startup needs to meet customers' demands regarding Diamond Maps™ and the RAFA System™, and
