WHEREAS, this legislative body adopted Act No. 95-2013 urging repeal of the New York SAFE Act of 2013, and

WHEREAS, Act No. 95-2013 declared that the SAFE Act is viewed by many citizens of the State of New York as an infringement upon the rights guaranteed to them by the 2nd Amendment; that the SAFE Act was adopted outside the normal course of the business of the Legislature, under the cover of darkness and with minimal discussion; that the SAFE Act contains serious flaws; and that the SAFE Act is opposed by a majority of citizens of Cattaraugus County, and

Carried.
