Care Management Facility \$11,937.45/year

212 Laurens Street (subject to increase based upon NYSDOL

Olean, New York 14760 Prevailing Wage Rates),

now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Legislature be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute a contract, between the Cattaraugus County Community Services Board and New York State Industries for the Disabled, Inc., to signify the County's approval, for the provision of the above-described janitorial services, contingent upon and subject to inclusion in the 2024 budget of sufficient funds to cover the costs of the aforementioned services, for a term commencing January 1, 2024 and terminating December 31, 2024, according to the above-described terms.
